Living Sent and Trusting the Sender

t was an ominous moment for the young missionary as he sat with his wife asleep with her head in his lap. They had arrived in the middle of the night at the international airport on one island as they awaited their morning flight to another island where they had come to live and serve. The airport was dark and almost lifeless as they found a plain cement bench as the most comfortable resting spot for their prolonged wait. As his wife slept, the reality of the moment began to sink in as he thought about what it meant to have left all that was known in order to step into all that was unknown.

Their journey had not started when they boarded the flight that had arrived a short time earlier. Oh no! They had been processing toward this moment of arriving in their country of service for a number of years. There had been that sense of God leading them to serve in His global mission well before they were ever married. Then came marriage, visiting their potential field, going through the process of being **sent**, studying language for a year in Europe, returning to the U.S. to ready their belongings for shipment to the island, and now this moment was in many ways the inauspicious culmination of multiple years of preparation.

In that moment the young man continued to process what indeed it meant to be **sent** in God's mission. In the stillness of those morning hours, Satan made it very clear that he would not be a passive participant in this endeavor. Deep, serious doubts invaded the thoughts of the missionary. His chest tightened, his heart raced, there was sweat on his brow and in his hands as he considered this reality of being **sent**. As the anxiety intensified and the confusing thoughts railed, the missionary had never felt such spiritual oppression in his life...(to be continued).

The words *mission* or *missions* do not appear in certain translations of the Bible (KJV). How then do we begin to formulate our beliefs and practices related to mission? The most common word in current usage that most closely conveys the biblical mandate of mission is the word **sent**. There are two prominent words in the original language that mean **sent**. The first one (*apostello*) has to do with sending in the sense of a commission...our commission is that we are sent. The other word (*pempo*) stresses the act of sending.

John 20:21 says, So Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent me, I also send you." Jesus' first usage of the word sent in this verse is apostello and His second use is the word pempo. Jesus said that just as I was sent (commissioned) you are also. And just as I literally and physically came, you must literally and physically go, because you are sent (pempo).

Both of these words are completely connected to the authority and purpose of the One who is sending! Jesus sent the twelve, the seventy, and His own disciples; and Paul stated many times in his New Testament writings that he was **sent**. All followers of Jesus through **His** church are **sent**! Therefore, we state here that the clearest biblical meaning of the word *mission* or *missions* is the concept of **sent**.

MISSIONS



...The young missionary wrestled a while longer with negative thoughts and fear. Then just as real as Satan's influence had been, the overwhelming presence of God took over the situation. The missionary began to remember Scripture and the Holy Spirit ministered to him through that never-changing truth of God's Word. It was as if God initiated a series of questions to the missionary:

Does your heart and life belong to the one and only Savior Jesus Christ? Yes!

Does the Holy Spirit dwell in you and enable you to do the things related to being **sent**? Yes! Is God's Word trustworthy and His promises to those who are **sent** valid? Yes!

The missionary bowed his head, and in a very intense moment of prayer he prayed, "Father, I know that you have redeemed me. I know that you have **sent** me here. I know that you cannot fail. Father, I also know that if you do not do this, it will not get done!" A prayer of desperation in a moment of crisis became the conduit for the cloud of darkness to be lifted and traded for a time of spontaneous praise and a heart and life that was reassured by its **Sender**.

Every missionary in this prayer calendar issue of *mission:world* magazine has experienced a similar happening to the one described here—and we all know that it happens repeatedly. Those who live **sent** are reminded daily of their desperate situation. However, it is a hopeful desperation because of the faithfulness of our **Sender**.

Isn't it interesting that the intimate moment with God that was spurred by the difficulty of the circumstances is in fact the way that we should interact and trust God in all situations? Mission is all about **send**! We go in the authority and purpose of our unfailing **Sender** Jesus Christ!
